# Aliens for sentences

Things the aliens might do (verbs):

skip clap hug stop knit jump  
help splash wash hiss wish clean  
zoom sleep fight twirl work meet  
cheat walk hike smile hope bake  
change like wave slide hide race

Use these verbs and the suffixes -ing and -ed to write sentences about what the aliens do.

E.g. Zolly washed all his socks.  
Floop makes hissing noises when he is sleeping.

Words that might describe the aliens (adjectives):

sad big thin long quick strong  
rich young soft mean light bright  
short tall straight calm fair neat  
sharp loud nice fine wide late  
rude pale brave

Use these adjectives and the suffixes -er and -est to write sentences that compare the aliens.

E.g. Floop has bigger horns than Dreve.  
Jally has got the biggest eye.
